

Mtskheta Tour



Mtskheta is an old capital of Georgia. Before 5th century AD it used to be capital of Georgia. Mtskheta is located 30 kilometers away from Tbilisi. It takes only 20 minutes to arrive in Mtskheta. First we will visit the 6th century monument Jvari Monasteri, where is buried first Georgian Christian King Mirian and Queen Nana. Splendid view lies over Mtskheta and is obviously seen the confluence of Mtkvari and Aragvi rivers.

After visiting Jvari Monastery we are passing towards Svetitskhoveli Cathedral. Svetitskhoveli is the monument dated from the 11th century and is the second biggest Cathedral after Trinity Cathedral. Svetitskhoveli is also considered as a burial place of Georgian Kings and noblemen.

Christ's robe is buried in Svetitskhoveli. Svetitskhoveli and Jvari Monastery are protected and considered as UNESCO world heritage. After the tour we will have lunch and go back to Tbilisi. Duration of tour is 4-5 hours.
